Our Due Diligence Process

- **Assessment:** We regularly assess our operations and supply chains to identify risks related to human rights and labor conditions.
- **Action:** When risks are identified, we take appropriate actions to address them. This might include changing suppliers, improving contracts, or directly engaging with affected stakeholders.
- **Reporting:** Each year, we publish a transparency report detailing our findings and the actions we've taken. This report is available on our website for our guests and stakeholders to review.
